

The Dorothy I. Parker Papers

Biographical History

Dorothy Inez Parker was born on January 23, 1910 in Traders Point, Indiana. She attended Butler University and received a B.S. in 1932. In 1934, at the University of Cincinnati, she earned her master's degree in Botany. Two years later, she completed work on her doctorate at the same institution.

At Brenau College, Dr. Parker served as the head of the Department of Biology from 1936 to 1938. In 1938, she returned to her alma mater, the University of Cincinnati, as the Instructor of Plant Ecology. After one year, Dr. Parker left the position to become the head of the Department of Biology at St. Mary's College in Indiana and to teach botany. After holding this position from 1939 to 1942, Parker transferred to the University of Notre Dame, serving as the assistant curator of the herbarium and the assistant editor of the "American Midland Naturalist."

In 1945, Dr. Parker left the teaching field and began her work with the Rockefeller Foundation. This arrangement lasted for nearly three decades. At the start of this career, Parker worked as a bibliographer and librarian for the Mexican Agricultural Program, editing publications and being in charge of the library. From 1945 to 1958, Parker was stationed in Mexico, supporting the organization of agricultural and university libraries and training library staffs across Latin America. She also helped found the Latin American Association of Agricultural Librarians.

From 1959 to 1960, Dr. Parker worked as a library advisor with the Indian Agricultural Program, focusing most of her attention on the establishment of a library wing at the Indian Agricultural Research Institute (IARI) in New Delhi.

In May 1960, Dr. Parker became Assistant Director for Agricultural Sciences at the Rockefeller Foundation's New York office. She was the first woman to be appointed to this position at the Foundation. Shortly thereafter, in 1963, she was promoted to Associate Director, a position she held until retirement in 1970. From 1960 to 1970, Dr. Parker was in charge of the library projects associated with all of the Foundation's programs. During this period, Parker continued to travel extensively through Europe, Asia, and Latin America, having a lasting impact on the agricultural and library science fields across the world.

In 1963, the Rockefeller Foundation published the International Bibliography of Rice Research with the International Rice Research Institute (IRRI). This was done by the Foundation at Dr. Parker's suggestion.

In 1967, Parker returned to India at the request of the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR). While there, she spent most of her time visiting and assessing agricultural universities and institutes which operated under the auspices of ICAR. She then compiled her assessments into a 243-page final report.

Although Dr. Parker officially retired from the Rockefeller Foundation in June 1970, she continued to work as a special consultant for the Agricultural Sciences at the Rockefeller Foundation, attending conferences and workshops. She served as a consultant to an important scientific conference of the International Maize and Wheat Improvement Center (CIMMYT) and

completed work with the Foundation's Cotton Project to analyze and gather information regarding the situation of world cotton. Upon receipt of a grant through the International Development Research Center (IDRC), Parker attended a meeting of the West African Agricultural Librarians and Documentalists through the International Institute of Tropical Agriculture (IITA). Also after retirement, she worked as a consultant for the Agency for International Development (AID), a division of the U.S. Department of State. She attended and participated in multiple conferences through AID.

Throughout her career, Dr. Parker was a distinguished author. Some of her most notable publications include Primer for Agricultural Libraries (April 1968), Library Report for the Indian Council on Agricultural Research (March 1969) and Guide for an Agricultural Library Survey for Developing Countries (1970).

Along with these outstanding achievements, Dr. Parker received many honors throughout her lifetime. She received postdoctoral fellowships to travel and research North American plant geography. Parker was also awarded a two-year postdoctoral fellowship by the American Association of University Women. She became an honorary member of the Asociacion Interamericana de Bibliotecarios y Documentalistas Agricolas (AIBDA) and served as the honorary president for their 1968 conference in Bogotá. Parker also served as a member of the executive committee of the International Association of Agricultural Librarians and Documentalists (IAALD). In addition, Parker was a fellow of both the American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS) and the Indiana Academy of Science. Parker was also elected to the Board of Trustees of The Western College, a small women's college in Ohio that later became part of Miami University.

Although she devoted most of her life's work to agricultural libraries and other library improvement programs, Dr. Parker set some time aside for herself and her hobbies. After retirement, she spent a month in Florence, Italy, restoring rare manuscripts and books damaged by flood waters. She also became a skilled bookbinder, a craft which she had studied in Mexico City and Florence. Her leather-bound books were beautifully decorated with intricate gold tooling and inlaid stones. In fact, Parker likely bound several of the volumes that are included in this collection. Through her lifetime, she also found interest in the arts, becoming a talented pipe organist and clarinetist and practicing her skill as a charcoal and watercolor sketch artist.

Dorothy Parker died at her home in White Plains, New York on July 30, 1999.

Scope and Content

Most of the material in this collection is related to the Rockefeller Foundation. With Dr. Parker's work spanning almost three decades, these papers demonstrate her dedication to the Foundation and its mission. Her efforts spanned the globe, as shown in the documents from Latin America, Europe, Asia, and elsewhere. Parker's influence on the Rockefeller Foundation's Agricultural Program can be seen in the collection, as well as her impact on libraries across the world. She kept detailed records of her travels, assignments, and library plans, all of which reveal much about her personality and character.

Few items in the collection shed light on Parker's life outside work, but this in fact reveals her sheer dedication to the agricultural and library sciences. Dr. Parker was a talented and accomplished woman who became highly respected at the Foundation, especially for being such an ambitious woman. Her expertise in multiple academic fields was respected by professional organizations across the world. Her work continued beyond her retirement, not only with the Rockefeller Foundation, but with other organizations as well as the U.S. Government. The collection spans from the late 1930s, when Parker finished her schooling, and continues through retirement into the early 1980s.

The Dorothy I. Parker Papers are arranged into 6 series, several of which are divided into subseries. With only a few exceptions, the folders are organized alphabetically by folder title. Within folders, documents are arranged chronologically.

Series Descriptions

Series 1 consists of eleven subseries, all of which are related to Rockefeller Foundation programs and/or Dorothy Parker's work with the Foundation.

Subseries 1, titled General Correspondence, consists of correspondence between Parker and Rockefeller Foundation individuals from 1945-1973. There are also library inquiries and information gathered in response to these inquiries.

Subseries 2, Publications, contains published materials from 1956-1985, which are related to Rockefeller Foundation programs, people, or grantees. Included in this subseries are reports, bibliographies, and publications written by Rockefeller Foundation employees. There are a few publications which do not have an apparent connection with the Rockefeller Foundation, yet upon closer review, they do. One is the Ford Foundation Annual Report, which mentions and describes collaboration between the Rockefeller Foundation and Ford.

Subseries 3, Assignments- Latin America, Mexican Agricultural Program, consists of materials related to Dorothy Parker's early career as a Rockefeller Foundation bibliographer and librarian in Mexico. These include publications and program papers from the Office of Special Studies, where Parker worked in Mexico. Parker worked with the Mexican Agricultural Program from 1945 to 1958. These materials span from 1938 to 1960.

Subseries 4, Assignments- Latin America, Agricultural Program, contains papers from Parker's work in Latin America, other than in Mexico. These range from travel schedules to correspondence, including library plans and publications. Most of the materials pertain to Parker's work in Colombia, but some relate to library projects in Guatemala, Costa Rica, and Peru. The materials range from 1950 to 1974.

Subseries 5, Assignments- Asia, Indian Agricultural Program (IAP), contains materials from the Indian Agricultural Program. Parker was stationed in India from 1959-1960 and during 1967. Included in this subseries are reports, drafts, and library improvement plans. The documents span from 1958 to 1973.

Subseries 6, Assignments- Asia, International Rice Research Institute (IRRI), contains numerous bibliographies, bibliography supplements, and publications. The primary publication, the International Bibliography of Rice Research, was published by the Rockefeller Foundation at Parker's suggestion. Other items relate to the planning of the IRRI Library in 1963. The materials range from 1960 to 1979.

Subseries 7, Assignments- Asia, Other Libraries, contains materials pertaining to library projects at three universities in Asia: Kasetsart University, Keio University, and the University of Philippines. These papers, from 1964-1974, pertain to Parker's work with the universities' libraries.

Subseries 8, Library Programs- Other, contains items from other library projects, some of which were agricultural libraries. Some of these resources may have been references for Parker's own library projects. Reports and miscellaneous travel information for other library programs are included in this subseries. Some documents were placed in this subseries because they are from the post-retirement period. The documents range from 1955 to 1979.

Subseries 9, Post-Retirement- Cotton Project, consists of items relating to the Rockefeller Foundation's Cotton Project, for which Parker was a consultant after her retirement. Many of these materials were collected by Parker as resources for the project. These include publications, pamphlets, and reports about textiles and cotton production. Meeting notes and travel information are included in this subseries. The materials span from 1940 to 1975.

Subseries 10, Post-Retirement- Other, includes miscellaneous, post-retirement consultant work for the Rockefeller Foundation and other Foundation-funded programs. Parker retired in 1970, so these materials include papers from conferences, seminars, and workshops after 1970. In 1975, through a grant from the International Development Research Center (IDRC), Parker attended an International Institute of Tropical Agriculture (IITA) conference. All materials related to these programs, ranging from 1968-1981, are included in this subseries.

Subseries 11, Rockefeller Foundation Programs- Other, includes materials from Rockefeller Foundation Programs that were not directly related to Dorothy Parker's work. In most instances, Parker was given this material after retirement because it was related to her line of work, yet she had no apparent part in the programs themselves. The documents span from 1973 to 1981.

Series 2, titled U.S. Government Departments and Programs, is divided into three subseries.

Subseries 1, Department of Agriculture, consists of publications from the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA). Most of the material is published by the National Agricultural Library as well as the Associates of the National Agricultural Library, a part of the USDA that received a Rockefeller Foundation grant in 1972. The documents range from 1962 to 1981.

Subseries 2, Department of State - Agency for International Development (AID), contains material from Parker's post-retirement consultant work with the agency. In particular, Parker was a consultant for the AID Library Panel through the National Science Foundation. Included in this subseries are publications from conferences, grantees, and research projects. Multiple bibliographies are included in this subseries, focusing on such topics as crops, land use, and urban development, among others. The materials span from 1968 to 1979.

Subseries 3, Other, contains miscellaneous government-related publications and program information, ranging from 1963 to 1971.

Series 3, United Nations, includes publications from U.N. agricultural and international development programs. These papers range from 1974 to 1975.

Series 4, Friends and Colleagues, consists of publications and ephemera from various friends and colleagues. Also included in this subseries is correspondence which does not relate to Rockefeller Foundation work. The documents span from 1950 to 1979.

Series 5, Professional Organizations, is divided into four subseries.

Subseries 1, Asociacion Interamericana de Bibliotecarios y Documentalistas Agricolas (AIBDA), includes newsletters and other materials from 1969-1981. Parker was an honorary member of the AIBDA.

Subseries 2, Instituto Interamericano de Ciencias Agricolas (IICA), contains publications and newsletters from 1970-1977.

Subseries 3, International Association of Agricultural Librarians and Documentalists (IAALD), consists of newsletters and other publications from 1959-1980. Parker was a member of the executive committee of the IAALD.

Subseries 4, Other, includes materials from miscellaneous organizations with which Dorothy Parker was connected during her lifetime. These include the Agricultural History Society, American Association of University Women, American Library Association, Antiquarian Booksellers Association of America, Inc., and the Association of Agricultural Librarians and Documentalists in India (AALDI). The papers from the American Association of University Women include biographical information on Parker. The materials range from 1955 to 1973.

Series 6, Miscellaneous/Ephemera, contains materials which have no apparent connection to any specific program or organization listed previously. This subseries includes publications and reports which mostly relate to agriculture and libraries. They may have been resources for her work. This subseries also contains reprints from Parker's early career, prior to her work with the Rockefeller Foundation. The documents range from 1932 through 1978.
