PREFACE

This *Survey of Sources at the Rockefeller Archive Center for the Study of Twentieth-Century Africa* is designed to provide its readers with a detailed introduction to the various collections at the Rockefeller Archive Center that contain material related to Africa. The introductory essay briefly reviews the various collections and discusses particular collections that contain small quantities of material on Africa -- the John D. Rockefeller Papers, the Rockefeller University Archives, the General Education Board Archives, the Laura Spelman Rockefeller Memorial Archives, and the International Education Board Archives. The remainder of the survey is divided into five parts, each of which presents a list of folder titles of Africa-related material in a specific collection. Part 1 lists the reports found in the records of the International Health Board/Division of the Rockefeller Foundation; Part 2 contains the titles of Africa-related grant files in the Rockefeller Foundation Archives; Part 3 lists the folders in the records of the Rockefeller Brothers Fund's West Africa Program; Part 4 highlights the Africa-related material in two series of the Nelson A. Rockefeller Papers; and Part 5 lists Africa-related material in the records of the Social Science Research Council.

This survey highlights only the most obvious source material relating to Africa. Readers should not assume that this is a comprehensive list of all Africa-related material available at the Rockefeller Archive Center, since each year new portions of the collections are made available for research and new collections are acquired. Readers are encouraged to contact the staff of the Rockefeller Archive Center about their research projects. Inquiries should be as specific as possible in describing the institutions and individuals who are the subjects of the study.

My colleagues on the staff of the Rockefeller Archive Center have provided invaluable assistance in the preparation of this survey. Monica Blank identified the relevant portions of the SSRC records for me, John LeGloahec called to my attention the Africa material in the Nelson A. Rockefeller Papers; and Lee Hiltzik described for me the portions of the Rockefeller University Archives that pertain to Africa. Erwin Levold, Tom Rosenbaum, and Darwin Stapleton brought to my attention particular portions of the RF records and provided useful comments and suggestions about the introductory essay. Pecolia Rieder greatly facilitated the survey's initial production and presentation in 1996, and Margaret Drum revised and updated it for a new edition in 2003. I am grateful to each of them for their assistance.

INTRODUCTION

AN OVERVIEW OF ROCKEFELLER PHILANTHROPY FOR AFRICA

The collections at the Rockefeller Archive Center constitute a rich and largely untapped source of primary material for students of Africa and the relationship between Africa and the United States. This preliminary survey of material relevant to Africa is designed to suggest the range of materials available at the Archive Center, as well as the variety of topics they document. Much of the material about Africa in these collections concerns public health and scientific research into the nature of particular diseases and their possible cures. These were the areas of concern to two organizations established by John D. Rockefeller -- the Rockefeller Institute for Medical Research (1901; renamed The Rockefeller University in 1965) and the Rockefeller Foundation (1913). The records of both organizations are located at the Rockefeller Archive Center.

The earliest contact with Africa to be found in the Center's collections is located in the papers of **John D. Rockefeller** (Record Group 1 in the Rockefeller Family Archives). As word of Rockefeller's charitable donations spread across the country in the 1880s and 1890s, he received numerous appeals for financial support. Missionaries in Africa and their proponents were among these correspondents. In April 1887, for example, the Rev. A.D. Noyes wrote to request Rockefeller's aid for the work of the Mt. Wallace Faith Mission in West Africa and toward the cost of a steam yacht, *Little Pilgrim*, for use on St. Paul's River and along the sea coast. Anna E. Bliss and her brother, Zenas W. Bliss, wrote Rockefeller separate letters in March 1893 in search of support for the Huguenot Seminary that Anna had founded in Wellington, South Africa. Charles Edward Ingham sought support for the work of the American Baptist Missionary Union in the Congo, and C. L. Powell hoped to receive aid for his work in North Africa. None of these African missionaries received Rockefeller's assistance. "I have so many pledges out [that I] must ask you to excuse me" from contributing, he replied to the Rev. Noyes. Although each of these missionaries wrote only one letter to Rockefeller and received no support, their single letters often contain biographical information and details of their plans and visions for their missionary work.¹

China was the part of the world that most completely captured the imagination of Rockefeller

corporate philanthropy in the early years of the 20th century, but the desire to expand worldwide the public health work begun in the U.S. by the Rockefeller Sanitary Commission for the Eradication of Hookworm Disease (1909-1914) led to contacts in Africa by 1920. The **International Health Board/Division**, established by the Rockefeller Foundation in 1913, was especially active in Africa, and the collection of correspondence, reports, memoranda, and scientific studies in its records constitute one of the largest bodies of Africa-related material in the Center's collection. A list of the routine and special reports submitted to the International Health Division appears in Part 1.

The International Health Division operated as a distinct division within **the Rockefeller Foundation** from 1913 until 1951, when it was merged into the foundation's medical sciences program. Active worldwide, the IHD launched scientific investigations and public health campaigns against hookworm, yellow fever, malaria, tuberculosis, yaws, schistosomiasis, and other diseases. Its investigations were conducted both in the field, especially in Africa, and in a special laboratory that it established on the campus of the Rockefeller Institute.² Table 1 summarizes the RF's work in Africa between 1914 and 1948, and shows how much of that work was in the field of public health.

The IHD often enjoyed the collaboration of investigators from **the Rockefeller Institute for Medical Research (RIMR)**. RIMR investigator **Hideyo Noguchi**, for example, worked with the IHD's West Africa Yellow Fever Commission in Accra.³ Researchers at the Institute made their own distinct contributions to African medicine and public health. They were instrumental in the scientific research that led to the development of Tryparsamide for the treatment of African sleeping sickness (trypanosomiasis), a disease transmitted throughout much of tropical Africa by the tsetse fly. The Institute patented the drug, and documentation related to the legal and business aspects of acquiring and maintaining the patent is located in the correspondence files of the Assistant Business Manager of the Institute (Record Group 212 of the Rockefeller University Archives). The Institute granted manufacturing licenses for Tryparsamide to pharmaceutical firms which were required to send batches to the RIMR for quality control testing. Not interested in receiving royalties, the Institute focused its concerns on the maintenance of drug standards as part of its sharpened sense of responsibility for the controlled exploitation of the products of its medical research.⁴

The Center's collections contain the papers of a number of research scientists at the Rockefeller Institute and field investigators for the IHD who spent time in Africa seeking cures for various illnesses. Two such collections are the papers of Louise Pearce (1885-1959) and Kenneth C. Smithburn (1904-1973).

Louise Pearce spent a major part of her career working on trypanosomiasis after joining the RIMR as a fellow in 1913. Appointed an associate member in 1923, she worked with Walter A. Jacobs and Michael Heidelberger, two chemists in Simon Flexner's laboratory, and she collaborated closely with biochemist Wade Brown. Together they investigated the effects of more than 200 arsenical compounds on trypanosomiasis. As part of their work, Pearce went to Leopoldville in the Belgian Congo where colonial medical officers were eager to see the effectiveness of the new compound, Tryparsamide, in the field. There she was given access to a government medical laboratory and a local clinic where patients with different stages of the disease were being treated. Tryparsamide proved to be decisively superior to previously used drugs in overcoming the Trypanosoma parasite in the bloodstream. In recognition for her work the Belgian government awarded Pearce the Order of the Crown of Belgium, and in 1953 she received the Royal Order of the Lion and received the King Leopold II Prize for her research and clinical efforts. In addition to Pearce's papers, the archives of The Rockefeller University includes the papers of her colleagues, **Walter A. Jacobs** and **Wade H. Brown**; additional records concerning Tryparsamide may be found in the Business Manager's subject files and the correspondence of Simon Flexner, director of the RIMR.⁵

Kenneth C. Smithburn was associated with both the Rockefeller Institute and the International Health Division. After a brief stint at Indianapolis City Hospital, Smithburn joined the staff of the Rockefeller Institute in 1930 and began a long association with the IHD in 1938, pursuing a lifelong interest in virus research at both institutions. He conducted extensive research in Africa. Among the many viruses and fevers that he researched are Bunyamwera Virus (1943-1948), Bwamba Fever Virus (1939-1943), Epidemic Hemorrhagic Fever (1952-1953), Rift Valley Fever (1944-1947), Semliki Forest Virus (1943-1944), West Nile Virus (1939-1943) and Yellow Fever (1938-1949). This experimental work was carried out in conjunction with a variety of scientific organizations or programs, including the Anthropod-Borne Virus Research Unit in South Africa (1959-1962), the Congo Program (with H. R. Jacobs and A. F. Mahaffy, 1940-1941), the Entebbe Group (1950-1953), the Virus and Rickettsial Disease Commission (1952-1953), the Virus Program of the RF (1947-1951), and the Virus Research

Program in South Africa (1956).⁶

Medicine and public health have not been the only programmatic concerns of the various Rockefeller corporate philanthropies in Africa. Higher education and the advancement of knowledge have been particular concerns of a number of Rockefeller philanthropies who began to express an interest in African education during the 1920s and 1930s, often working with officials from the Phelps-Stokes Fund. In 1923, for example, the **International Education Board** contributed \$6,000 toward the Fund's Educational Commission to East Africa, and the following year it appropriated \$2,500 to the Fund to co-sponsor a tour of African-American colleges and universities in the South by a group of African educators. Also in 1924 the IEB voted to contribute \$500 toward a visit to the U.S. by the South African educator Charles T. Loram, whose visit was delayed until 1926.⁷ Two Africans received IEB fellowships in 1926: Vivian Voss, a South African physicist who spent his fellowship year studying at Johns Hopkins University, and Hans Theiler, who used his agricultural fellowship to study at the New York State Veterinary College and at the Rockefeller Institute for Medical Research.⁸

In 1925 the leaders of the IEB and other Rockefeller philanthropies heard two speakers discuss conditions in Africa at their periodic Interboard Luncheons. On May 25, 1925, Thomas Jesse Jones, educational director of the Phelps-Stokes Fund, discussed education and health in Africa, and on October 26, 1925, Dr. J.H. Oldham of the International Missionary Council discussed the needs of Africa and how philanthropy might help. Summaries of these discussions are contained in the file on "Interboard Luncheons, 1924-1927," in the International Education Board archives, box 8, folder 121. Oldham's summary of his discussions with officials of the IEB and the Laura Spelman Rockefeller Memorial, and his plans for what became the International Institute for African Language and Culture are preserved in a file in the records of the Laura Spelman Rockefeller Memorial (LSRM). In October 1926 the LSRM

voted to support the institute at a rate of \$5,000 a year for five years, and the Rockefeller Foundation continued to support this organization into the 1950s.⁹

The **Laura Spelman Rockefeller Memorial** was especially interested in the development of the social sciences, and during 1925-1926 representatives of the LSRM discussed with several people the possibility of conducting studies in Africa on the general theme of racial psychology. Such discussions were held with Ellsworth Faris, a former missionary in Africa who was interested in studying Africans in the Congo, and Clark Wissler, who was interested in conducting anthropological studies in Africa and the West Indies.¹⁰ In November 1927 LSRM staff member Leonard Outhwaite met with Edgard Brookes of the University of South Africa to discuss plans for the development of the social sciences in South Africa.¹¹ The files contain no evidence that these discussions resulted in financial support from the LSRM.

During the 1930s, the International Education Board provided support for two schools in Liberia: the Booker Washington Agricultural and Industrial Institute of Liberia at Kakata (\$13,000) and the College of West Africa in Monrovia (\$5,000). This support went toward buildings and equipment at the former school and for books and laboratory equipment at the latter. Nine folders of correspondence, reports, and meeting minutes document the IEB's support for these schools,¹² which was channeled through the New York State Colonization Society.

To some extent the IEB's interest in Africa stemmed from the personal interest of two members of the **General Education Board**, Eben C. Sage and Jackson Davis, both of whom served as president of the New York State Colonization Society. The General Education Board (GEB) was not legally empowered to undertake work outside of the U.S., which is one reason why John D. Rockefeller, Jr. established the International Education Board in 1923, so that Sage and Davis turned to the IEB for

assistance in Africa. Even though the GEB could not provide funds for education in Africa, its records nevertheless contain documentation of its members' contacts regarding African education. Two folders contain correspondence and reports regarding "Education in Liberia, 1907-1933,"¹³ including material on the College of West Africa (formerly Monrovia Seminary); the advance sheets for George W. Ellis's "Education in Liberia" (1907); "Report of Benjamin Brawley on Liberia College" (May 1920, 28 pp.); and correspondence with Edward B. Merrill; Walter F. Walker, a native of Alabama and secretary of the Department of Public Instruction in Liberia; Mississippi native H.H. Jones; the Rev. W.W. Matthews of the Department of Foreign Missions of the AME Zion Church, writing on behalf of Mt. Coffee Mission; and Nathaniel H.B. Cassell, the president of Liberia College. Also included are the minutes of a December 1913 meeting in London of the Society for the Establishment and Maintenance of the Liberian Industrial Training Institution and Schools, and the minutes of the March 1924 Conference of Representatives of Colonization Societies and Mission Boards Interested in Liberia. Sage attended the latter meeting in New York City as a representative of the New York State Colonization Society and was elected as conference chairman; the conference soon established an Advisory Committee on Education in Liberia, and these folders contain some of the minutes and notes regarding that committee's work.

As with the IEB, the GEB maintained close contact with the Phelps-Stokes Fund, and their general contacts between 1918 and 1960 are documented in the GEB Archives.¹⁴ One particular project on which the two philanthropies cooperated was an educational survey of Africa undertaken in the early 1940s by Jackson Davis, Thomas M. Campbell and Margaret Wrong, which resulted in *Africa Advancing: A Study of Rural Education and Agriculture in West Africa and the Belgian Congo* (1945). Davis's files regarding this project are located in the GEB Archives¹⁵ and include his correspondence with his fellow investigators; correspondence with Claude Barnett of the Associated Negro Press about the trip and its publicity and about African politics in general; clippings regarding the trip and reviews of the book; files on the Belgian Congo, the Gold Coast, Liberia, and Nigeria; and correspondence with the Church Missionary Society Training School, the Committee for African Students in North America, and the International African Institute. Additional material regarding this survey and the book is located in the small collection of Jackson Davis Papers at the Archive Center.

African education has been a special interest of the Rockefeller Foundation, especially after

World War II, as the list of RF project files in Part 2 shows. The organization of the Rockefeller Foundation archives facilitates research for scholars interested in specific geographic areas, for material related to a particular country was assigned a unique number, so that all material pertaining to that country is collected together. In the case of Africa, as Part 2 indicates, the foundation assigned unique numbers to specific regions of the continent in the 1920s, and was forced to modify this mark-up system over time as the political situation changed. Material in the Rockefeller Foundation's grant files is available for research once the material is twenty years old.

A Rockefeller philanthropy with a special interest in Africa has been the **Rockefeller Brothers Fund** (RBF). Established in 1940 by the children of John D. Rockefeller, Jr. -- Abby, John D. 3rd, Nelson A., Laurance S., Winthrop, and David -- the RBF has been active internationally since the 1950s and in the late 1950s established a special West Africa Program. The records of the West Africa Program consist of 12.4 cubic feet of documents and 397 photographs.¹⁶ The bulk of this material dates between 1957 and 1963, the period during which its Lagos office was in full operation.

The RBF's West Africa Program was designed to provide technical assistance tailored to the economic development needs of Ghana and Nigeria. The West Africa Program was not a grant-making operation; instead, the RBF contracted with outside consultants to prepare economic feasibility studies at the request of government ministries or industrialists and private investors. Each study examined in depth a specific aspect of that nation's economic potential and needs, and was designed to provide a realistic framework for action. The Program's main office in Lagos, Nigeria served as the distribution point for these studies, and its director, Robert I. Fleming, acted as a liaison between the governments of Togo, Ghana, and Nigeria and groups of U.S. investors. The office organized investigative tours for these investors and arranged their contacts with governmental personnel. A list of the folder titles in the West Africa Program records, and the titles of the feasibility studies, appears in Part 3.

The RBF was active in Africa in other ways as well, as its grant files amply demonstrate. One organization which the RBF supported was the African American Institute (AAI).¹⁷ The RBF's grant files on African American Institute cover the years 1953-1979 and comprise four cubic feet of material. The RBF files include information on a number of other organizations of interest to students of Africa and

U.S.-African relations. Relevant files include the African Affairs Society of America (formerly Pan-Africa Society of America); the African Wildlife Husbandry Development Association, 1974-1987; the African Wildlife Leadership Foundation, Inc., 1961-1988; Africare, 1971-1979; Alliance High School, Kenya, 1967-1969; the Republic of Botswana, 1974-1979; the Botswana Society, 1972-1976; Kenya, 1953-1959; Kenya National Parks, 1971-1975; the Ngamiland Youth Training Center, Maun, Botswana, 1972-1975; the Olatunji Center for African Culture, 1968-1976; Operation Crossroads Africa, Inc., 1962-1976; the South African Institute of Race Relations, 1956-1985; Tanzania National Parks, 1962-1974; Uganda National Parks, 1965-1977; and the United States-South Africa Leader Exchange Program, Inc., 1951-1983. Material in the RBF's grant files that is more than ten years old is open for research.

Members of the Rockefeller family have had their own contacts with Africa independent of the various philanthropies that have been created with family money. During the 1920s **John D. Rockefeller, Jr.** provided funding for two Africa-related projects. In 1924 he provided \$2,500 to underwrite the activities of the Committee on African Welfare, whose founding members included Raymond B. Fosdick, George Foster Peabody, the Rev. Thomas S. Donohugh, Fennell P. Turner, and A.L. Warnshuis. The committee, formed as a result of reports of slavery in the Portuguese colonies in Africa, used the funds to send University of Wisconsin professor E.A. Ross to investigate the "labor problem" there. Rockefeller gave the committee another \$750 to enable it to publish Ross's findings, although a copy of the report is not included in the file.¹⁸ In December 1927 JDR Jr. pledged \$25,000 toward the construction of a building in South Africa to be used as the headquarters of a leadership training program operated by Max Yergan, an African-American who had been sent to South Africa by the National Council of the YMCA. The file on Yergan's work is extensive and illustrates the broad network that arose to lend moral as well as financial support to his work.¹⁹

Nelson A. Rockefeller had more extensive contacts in Africa than did his father. As Part 4 shows, his general correspondence related to Africa spans the years 1949-1971. Relevant material can be found in two series -- the Countries series and the Activities series -- within the Nelson A. Rockefeller Personal Papers, Record Group 4 of the Rockefeller Family Archives. Additional material may be located in the Vice Presidential Central Files, and there is some material on Rhodesia in the Vice

Presidential Press Releases (box 27) and material on Angola in Vice Presidential Speeches (box 1).

The continent of Africa has not attracted the devoted attention of Rockefeller philanthropy in the way that Latin America captured Nelson Rockefeller's attention, or in the way that Asia attracted John D. Rockefeller 3rd, or the way that China interested Frederick T. Gates and John D. Rockefeller, Jr. But the records at the Rockefeller Archive Center show that the Rockefeller philanthropic concern for "the well-being of mankind" has made Africa the focus of increased attention throughout the twentieth century and the target of specific program initiatives since the end of World War II. The Center's collections offer students of Africa and U.S.-African relations a rich body of materials through which they can view African social and economic development, and the changes in American attitudes and concerns about Africa.

Three series of records within the Rockefeller Foundation Project (Grant) files contain material related to the RF's support for individuals and institutions in Africa. These are designated Record Group 1.1, Record Group 1.2 and Record Group 1.3. The distinction refers to the different times at which the three sets of material were deposited at the Rockefeller Archive Center, but generally the material in RG 1.1 is earlier than that in RG 1.2, and 1.2 is earlier than RG 1.3.

The Project (Grant) Files in the Rockefeller Foundation Archives have been organized by country or region. Each country, or, in the case of Africa, particular regions of the continent were assigned a specific numeric code. Regional designations include 475 for Africa in general, 477 for East Africa, 485 for North Africa, 487 for the South African Region, and 495 for West Africa. Readers are advised to consult the finding aid list for the appropriate regional series as well as for the specific country series that is of interest.

Within these regional and country series, material is organized by subject using an alphabetical code. The following letter codes appear in the Africa portion of the Rockefeller Foundation Archives:

SERIES E. COUNTRIES SERIES

The Countries Series contains Nelson A. Rockefeller's correspondence with private individuals and representatives of institutions and governments in eighty-seven foreign countries. With some exceptions this material consists mainly of financial appeals from individuals and institutions. Appeals from individuals include requests for money for such things as starting a business, transportation to the U.S., or publishing a book. The range of institutions includes churches, universities, health centers and businesses. Because Rockefeller followed his family's philanthropic tradition of aiding people through institutions rather than individually, nearly all of the personal appeals were declined.

Only those institutional appeals which fell within Rockefeller's areas of interest were favorably answered. Most of the declination letters were written by members of Rockefeller's staff on his behalf.

While some scattered documents are dated as early as 1931, the bulk of the material covers the period from 1945 to 1971. In accordance with Rockefeller family office filing procedures, appeals from individuals prior to 1958 were discarded.

PART 5. SOCIAL SCIENCE RESEARCH COUNCIL (SSRC) COLLECTION, 1924-1990

The Social Science Research Council is a private not-for-profit organization established to advance research in the social sciences. The Council came into being in 1923 as a result of the initiative of Wesley C. Mitchell and Charles E. Merriam, members of the American Political Science Association. Representatives from the American Economic Association, the American Sociological Society, the American Statistical Association, the American Historical Association and the American Psychological Association joined with Merriam and his associates to form the Social Science Research Council and invited the participation of other national associations in anthropology, history, and psychology. The Council was incorporated on December 27, 1924.

The Social Science Research Council records were donated to the Rockefeller Archive Center by the Council in 1990. The collection is open for research with the exception of those folders marked closed. Closed material is restricted for thirty years from the date of origin. The fellowship files in boxes 21 through 44 are open to researchers pending review by the archivists at the time of the request.

The Council's collection is divided into two categories. Accession 1 (Record Group 1) contains the first group of documents donated to the Archive Center in 1990. Accession 2 (Record Group 2) contains the second and larger bulk of material transferred to the Archive Center in 1994. Much of the earlier Council material, from the 1920s to the 1940s is missing, but older Council documents can be found in the collections of the Rockefeller Foundation and the Laura Spelman Rockefeller Memorial.

Although some of the Council's files are missing or still stored in New York City, some series of the collection are well documented. Particular Committee Projects have extensive records, and this includes Subseries 1. Committee on African Studies.
