*A Survey of Sources at the Rockefeller Archive Center for the History of Nursing* was compiled by archivist Emily J. Oakhill. A paper version was last updated and published in April 1990; this online version was edited and reformatted by Kenneth W. Rose and John LeGloahec.

## **INTRODUCTION TO THE ORIGINAL EDITION**

This survey of sources includes material directly relating to nursing, nursing education, and public health nursing. While the survey may be regarded as complete within these boundaries, scholars should not limit their study to only those records listed.

The following are additional topic areas in which material on nursing may be found: child health; family health; health education; hospitals (general or specific); maternity care and midwifery; medical care (general); nutrition; public health activities (general); Rockefeller Foundation RG 3, Administration, Program and Policy; general “state of the division” reports; and specific diseases. Folders of material on these topics have not been included unless it was apparent or known that material on nursing exists in those folders.

Unless otherwise stated, material listed is processed and open for research.

“Processed” indicates that the material has been put in order with some preservation steps taken and that there are finding aids available.

A large photograph collection includes many photographs of nurses (in classes and at work), nursing residences, and hospitals around the world.

The China Medical Board of New York, Inc. was incorporated in 1928 to take over the Peking Union Medical College (PUMC) program from the Rockefeller Foundation. The school of nursing was an integral part of the PUMC.

**COMMONWEALTH FUND Archives, 1918-1982**

The Commonwealth Fund was established in 1918 with a gift of approximately \$10 million from Mrs. Stephen V. Harkness for “benevolent, religious, educational and like purposes.” Despite an earlier decision that there was already great philanthropic work in the area of medical research, by the mid-1920s the chief interest of the Fund had become health.

**ADVANCED MEDICAL FELLOWSHIPS**

Fellowships are an integral part of the Commonwealth Fund’s history and continually supported the varied public health, mental hygiene and rural hospital programs of the Fund.

### **DIVISION OF RURAL HOSPITALS**

In 1925 the Fund established this division to improve rural hospital services. The selection of sites was determined by the capacity and willingness of rural communities to help themselves. In districts lacking both towns of more than 12,000 people and hospitals, the Fund supplied the greater part, if not all, of the building costs, with the community providing the remainder and then maintaining the institutions.

## GENERAL EDUCATION BOARD Archives, 1901-1964

The General Education Board was established in 1903 by John D. Rockefeller to aid education in the U. S. “without distinction of race, sex, or creed.” The program included grants for endowment and general budgetary support of colleges and universities, support for special programs, fellowship and scholarship assistance to state school systems at all levels, and development of social and economic resources as a route to improved educational systems. After 1940, programs other than those for Southern education were brought to a close; funds were nearly exhausted by the 1950s, and the last appropriation was made in 1964.

## **LAURA SPELMAN ROCKEFELLER MEMORIAL Archives, (1918-1930)-1949**

The Laura Spelman Rockefeller Memorial was incorporated in 1918 for general philanthropic purposes, and was named for the late wife of John D. Rockefeller, Sr. The LSRM operated from the office of John D. Rockefeller, Jr. with a fluid program until 1922, when Beardsley Ruml was named director and developed a long-range program. Areas of special interest were child study, education, public health, race relations, religion, social studies, and social welfare. The LSRM merged with the Rockefeller Foundation in 1929.

## **MEMORIAL SLOAN - KETTERING CANCER CENTER Archives, 1884-1989**

The New York Cancer Hospital was established in 1884, one of the first hospitals devoted entirely to the treatment and research of cancer. From 1889 until 1916, the hospital was known as General Memorial Hospital for Cancer and Allied Diseases. The word "General" was eliminated in 1916. The Sloan-Kettering Institute was incorporated in 1945 to conduct intensive research in oncology. Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center was formed in 1960 to serve as an administrative umbrella for the Hospital and the Institute.

The Rockefeller Brothers Fund was established in 1940 by John D. 3rd, Nelson, Laurance, Winthrop and David Rockefeller. It makes grants to local, national, and international philanthropic organizations that depend on the general public for funds.

## ROCKEFELLER FOUNDATION Archives, 1910-(1912-1989)

The Rockefeller Foundation was established in 1913 by John D. Rockefeller “to promote the well-being of mankind throughout the world.” From its earliest years, the Foundation has been both a grant-making and a direct operating institution. In 1919, medical education became a major interest, including nursing, midwifery, hospital and dispensary development in the United States and around the world. The Foundation’s greatest activity in nursing ended with the outbreak of World War II in 1939.

Rockefeller Foundation material included in this survey which is more than 20 years old is open for research unless otherwise stated.

### RECORD GROUP 1: PROJECT FILES

The project files are divided by date of material into record groups (RG 1.1, 1.2, etc.). Each project file within these groups is distinguished by an arbitrarily chosen country number followed by a letter indicating the program under which the project falls. Individual project titles alphabetically arranged then follow.

The Peking Union Medical College was established in 1917 as part of the CMB’s program, designed to be a research center as well as a medical school. The Board ceased to be a division of the RF in 1927, and the funding of medical projects in Asia was taken over by the Medical Education Division of the Foundation. The PUMC was taken over by a new foundation, the China Medical Board, Inc.

## ROCKEFELLER FOUNDATION RECORD GROUP 6: FIELD OFFICES

During the course of its history, the Rockefeller Foundation has established field offices in different parts of the world, including Bahia; Belem and Rio de Janeiro in Brazil; Santiago, Chile (see below); Bogota, Colombia; Cali, Colombia (see below); Guatemala; Poona, India; Indonesia; Nairobi, Kenya; Nigeria; the Philippines; Ankara, Turkey; St. Lucia in the West Indies; and Zaire. The records of three field offices have been processed: New Delhi, India; Mexico (1943-1965), and Paris (see below), and finding aids are available at the Rockefeller Archive Center.

Material more than 20 years old is open for research.

### Series 6.1 Paris Field Office, 1917-1959

The International Health Board of the Rockefeller Foundation opened an office in Paris in 1917 as headquarters for the work of the Commission for the Prevention of Tuberculosis in France. In 1922, anticipating the transfer of the tuberculosis work to the French and an expansion of the foundation's work in Europe, the Board agreed to share space and administrative expenses with other divisions of the foundation. The office served as the foundation's fiscal agent with respect to European (and sometimes beyond) affairs. The office also administered appropriations made at the discretion of the Paris officers and acted as fiscal agent for other U.S. organizations. The office was closed in 1959.

The material is organized into two series, Prewar and Postwar, divided by World War II.

## SEALANTIC FUND Records, 1931-1980

The Sealantic Fund was established in 1938 by John D. Rockefeller, Jr. to give support to institutions and programs in which he took a personal interest. The Fund was merged with the Rockefeller Brothers Fund in 1973.

In 1958 John D. Rockefeller, Jr., gave \$1,473,800 to the Sealantic Fund specifically for support in the fields of nursing education and the utilization of nursing services. The grants were made in five general areas: to intensify programs which encouraged recruits into the nursing field, the development of two-year courses in basic nursing at community colleges, pilot programs in collegiate schools of nursing to prepare nurses as teachers, grants for baccalaureate nursing scholarships, and research into the economic utilization of nursing and related personnel in the operation of hospitals. Scholarships of between \$4,000 and \$24,000 (totaling \$332,800) were given to thirty-two colleges and universities to use at their discretion. There was no application procedure or competition for the funding.
